Ending Hunger Results for 2015

Through the efforts of the staff members and very generous members of Sebasticook Valley FCU, the Maine Credit Unions' Campaign for Ending Hunger for 2015 had another banner year raising **\$27,150** for this very worthy cause. These funds will be distributed to hunger organizations throughout the Sebasticook Valley area.



This year, ten organizations will directly benefit from the hard work and generosity of our employees and our members. Pittsfield Community Christmas Project (the food pantry for Pittsfield), Newport Community Food Bank, Corinna Food Pantry, Tri-Town Food Pantry (which serves Hartland, St. Albans and Palmyra) and The Widows and Orphans Food Pantry in Stetson will receive funds this year. Also receiving funds are the Sebasticook Family Doctors/RSU #19 Back Pack Program and the MSAD #53/Warsaw and Vickery Schools snack pack programs. These programs provide meals and snacks to students during school vacations. Sometimes the only meals that some students are getting are the school provided breakfast and lunch. During school vacations, they do not have that available to them.

These snack pack programs help to alleviate that need. Another great program that these funds help support

is the Healthy SV Farm Share Program. This program works with local farmers to provide vouchers to seniors in our area. Seniors can use these vouchers to buy fresh produce from these farmers. A win-win situation for local farmers and local seniors! Funds are also given to help the Hartland Consolidated School in-school food pantry. We will be distributing the Ending Hunger funds to representatives of these organizations at our Annual Meeting which will be held at our Newport branch on Wednesday, April 13, 2016 at 5:30 P.M.

We would like to thank our members for their continued support year after year of the Maine Credit Unions' Campaign for Ending Hunger. Please know that every penny raised from this campaign is given to the above mentioned hunger organizations to help our neighbors in need.
